



QAYG Layer Cake BoM

Finished quilt size: 51" x 68" approx.

Welcome to the club! It's not official – it just sounds cool.

What is the QAYG Layer Cake BoM?

It's a quilt made from twelve quilted blocks sewn together with thin sashing strips on the back and front. The blocks themselves are made from sixteen HSTs.

Each month on the shop's newsletter and social media there will be an announcement that the pattern for the next block is available to download. And as the DeAgostini adverts says 'it builds into this lovely quilt'.

We would be grateful if you would share your blocks with us each month. You can send them to us via email, or our Facebook page, or, if you are that way inclined, on Instagram using the hashtag #sbyslayercakebom and don't forget to tag us. We love seeing what you make!

What's with all the acronyms?

The quilty world is full of them, here's the ones you'll come across here and throughout:

- QAYG – quilt as you go
- BoM – block of the month
- HST – half square triangle
- WOF – width of fabric

What do I need?

- One Layer Cake
- 55cm by WOF of 'background' fabric – this should coordinate with your chosen Layer Cake, because you need an extra six 10" squares
- 1.5m of 90" wide wadding
- 1m of 108" wide quilt backing, or 12 fat quarters
- 20cm by WOF of fabric for front sashing strips
- 25cm by WOF of fabric for back sashing strips
- 50cm by WOF of binding fabric
- Coordinating threads for piecing and quilting

Anything else?

It wouldn't hurt to have:

- a ¼" foot for your machine
- a marking pen
- a 4½" or 6½" square Creative Grids ruler – this helps with the squaring of the HSTs
- a can of 505 spray
